THIRTY THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - YEAR C

Do not give anyone food who refuses to work.

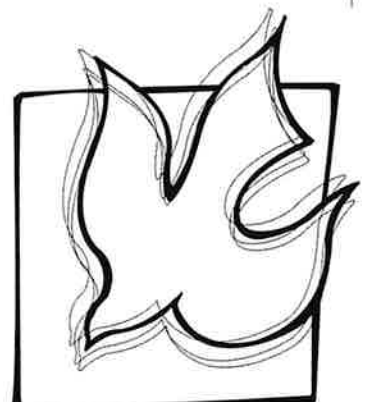
